



Patient Instructions Stool for Occult Blood

- 1. For accurate test results, apply samples from bowel movements collected on <u>three</u> different days to the cards (slides) provided by the laboratory or your physician's office. Your physician may request one sample only, but three is recommended.
- 2. Avoid non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs such as ibuprofen, naproxen or aspirin for 7 days before and during the stool collection. Avoid vitamin C in excess of 250 mg per day and red meats (beef, lamb and liver) for 3 days prior to and during the stool collection. *Please speak with your physician about taking specific medications during stool collection.*
- 3. Do not collect stool if blood is visible in you stool or urine due to menstruation, active hemorrhoids, or urinary tract infection. Contact your physician.
- 4. Collect each stool sample before contact with the toilet bowl water. You may use any clean, dry container to obtain the stool.
- 5. With the stick or swab provided, wipe a portion of the stool on the two areas of the card (slide) "Box A" "Box B". Close the flap.
- 6. Label each slide with your Name/Last Four of your Social Security #/Date & Time of Collection / Requesting Physician's Name.
- 7. Protect the slides from heat, light, and volatile chemicals such as iodine, ammonia, bleach and household cleaners.
- 8. Return the completed slides to the laboratory no later than 14 days after your first sample is collected.
